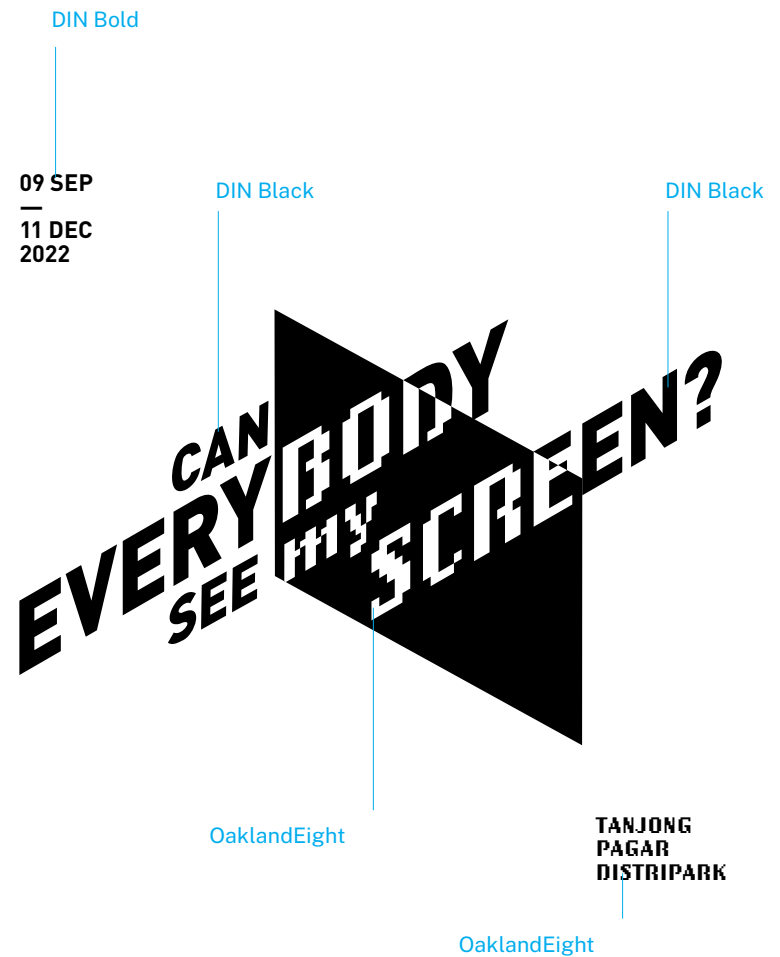
# CAN EVERYBODY SEE MY SCREEN

# Colour Applications

In situations where colours are needed, they should be applied as “glitches” to the background of the main identity. The “screen” should remain black or white (for reversed applications).

Some examples below with recommended colour combinations:

-  100c 75m / #231F20  
Pantone 2728C
-  60c 100y / #39b54a  
Pantone 74C044
-  75c 100m 20k / #551f7a  
Pantone 268C
-  20c 100m 15y / #ec008c  
Pantone C8187E
-  50m 100y / #f7941d  
Pantone 1495C



# Application on Image

In situations when the Identity is placed over an image, the single colour black or white mark is preferred. (Depending on the colour and complexity of the image).



## Application on Image (Colour)

In situations where the coloured version of the identity is used, they should be applied as “glitches” to the background of the main identity. The “screen” should remain black or white (for reversed applications).

Colours chosen should compliment the imagery.



# On-site Applications

For on-site application, it is recommended to use either only the single colour black or white application for vinyl cut. However, if the coloured version is preferred, they should be applied as “glitches” to the background of the main identity. The “screen” should remain black or white (for reversed applications).\*
